

Frequently Asked Questions for: The Group, Private, and Moonlight Stagecoach Rides

What should I wear, bring, and not bring with me?

- **Dress for the weather! Long pants, closed toed shoes, and a hat are always recommended if you explore the ranch!**

Our stagecoach is authentic, complete with open windows for gazing! Dress for the weather before your ride! Pants or jeans will protect your legs from the elements during the winter and summer months. Layering tops and shirts may help prepare for unpredictable warm or cold weather, which you can determine when you arrive for check-in. Blankets are a great idea during the winter time!

- **Bring a drink!**

Wet your whistle! Bring a bottle of water, coffee, or another beverage for your 45-minute ride! **Please, NO alcoholic beverages.** Hot coffee or tea is great for the winter and water is always recommended during the spring and summer. During the warmer months, having an extra bottle of water before and after your tour is highly recommended! Eat a small snack or meal before your ride, especially if you are scheduled for the morning. Food will not be permitted on the ride, thank you for helping keep our desert and stagecoach clean!

- **Medical Emergency Items: inhalers, epi-pens, emergency medications, etc.**

Upon check-in, please notify the office or wrangler of any emergency medical supplies that must come on the ride so it may be packed appropriately!

- **Only the necessities: diaper bag, purse, and a camera!**

Due to the limited seating, inside and atop the stagecoach please only bring the necessities. There are plenty of safe places to park a stroller at the ranch and cabinets at the front office to put away any additional bags or items. Expensive belongings such as jewelry and tablets that may easily get lost, are better left at home. Don't forget your camera or phone to snap photos! Please silence your phones for the best experience.

Ride Restrictions

Limited seating: 8 participants inside, 2 on top with the driver. Participants must be agile enough to climb up and down, if sitting with driver.

- No required, minimum riding age. Anyone can ride in the stagecoach!
- Children under 2 years old are FREE – **and must sit on a parent's lap.**
- No weight limit.

- We do not allow pregnant women to ride for their safety and the safety of their child.

If any participant has limitations, handicaps, or disabilities, and you are unsure if they can join the ride - please call and talk with the front office!
